SUNDAY REFLECTION

Today —in these days of «stormy weather»— we find the Gospel being held up to questioning. Humanity has gone through dramas which, like violent waves, have broken over individuals and entire peoples, particularly during the 20th century and the troubles of the 21st. Sometimes we can't help but ask «Master, don't you care if we sink?» (Mk 4,38); If You really do exist, if You are our Father, how can these things happen?

Before the horror of the memory of the concentration camps of the Second World War Pope Benedict asks «Where was God when this was happening, Why did He stay silent? How could He tolerate such excessive destruction?». It was a question that the people of Israel asked in the Old Testament: «Why are you asleep? (...) Why do you hide your face from us and forget about our plight?».

God will not answer those questions: of him we can ask everything except why; we have no right to demand explanations. In fact, God is there and is talking; the problem is us, because we do not put ourselves in his presence and therefore cannot hear his voice. «We cannot decipher God's secret —says Pope Benedict XI—. We can only see fragments of it and are in the wrong if what we are trying is to become judges of God and History. As such we would not be defending humanity, but rather would be contributing to its destruction».

Therefore, the problem is not whether God exists or is here with us or not. The problem is that we live as if He didn't exist. Here is God's answer: «Why are you so afraid? How can you not have faith?» (Mc 4,40). This Jesus said that to His disciples; He also said it to Saint Faustina Kowalska: «My daughter, do not be afraid, I am always with you even when it looks as though I am not».

Let us not ask him questions, but rather let us pray and accept His will and... then there will be less dramas, and, amazed, we will say «Who is he whom even the wind and the sea obey him?» (Mc 4,41) —Jesus, I put all my trust in you!

On June 27, in the liturgy of the Catholic Church, we celebrate the memory of Our Lady of Perpetual Help. In our church, every Saturday after the Polish Mass we have a Novena to Our Lady of Perpetual Help. On the first Saturdays of the month we will have a novena after the 7 am Mass.

This week, the image of Our Lady will return to the church and will be

placed next to the cross in the main altar.

Our Lady of Perpetual Help is a title given to the Blessed Virgin Mary. This title is associated with an icon of Our Lady from the late 1400s.

The icon depicting Our Lady of Perpetual Help is thought to have been originally painted in the 1200s. The image shows Mary holding the Christ Child. Sts. Gabriel and Michael are seen holding instruments of Christ's Passion near Mary and the Christ Child.

Our Lady of Perpetual Help can be a powerful intercessor for us. You can use this novena to seek intercession from Our Lady of Perpetual Help in any area of your life!

KATECHIZM KOŚCIOŁA KATOLICKIEGO

Jaką rolę odgrywa Pismo Święte w życiu Kościoła?

Kościół z Pisma Świętego czerpie swoje życie i swoją siłę. Kościół wielbi Bożą obecność w Piśmie Świętym z niemniejszą czcią niż Chrystusa w EUCHARYSTII. Podczas Mszy Świętej słuchamy Ewangelii, stojąc, ponieważ w tych ludzkich słowach przemawia do nas sam Bóg.



ROZWAŻANIE NA NIEDZIELĘ

Dzisiaj, w tych czasach «gęstej mgły» zadajemy to samo ewangeliczne pytanie. Ludzkość przeżyła dramaty, które jak silne fale przetoczyły się nad mężczyznami i kobietami, i całymi narodami, w szczególności te w XX wieku i na początku XXI. I czasem z głębi duszy wydobywa się wołanie: «Nauczycielu, nic Cię to nie obchodzi, że giniemy?» (Mk 4,38); jeśli naprawdę istniejesz, jeśli Ty jesteś Ojcem, dlaczego dzieją się te rzeczy?

Wobec wspomnienia zagłady obozów koncentracyjnych II Wojny Światowej, Papież Benedykt pyta: «Gdzie był wtedy Bóg? Dlaczego milczał? Jak mógł dopuścić ten bezmiar zniszczenia?». To samo pytanie zadawał Izrael już w Starym Testamencie: «Ocknij się! Dlaczego śpisz, Panie? Przebudź się! Nie odrzucaj na zawsze! Dlaczego ukrywasz Twoje oblicze? Zapominasz o nędzy i ucisku naszym?» (Ps 44,24-25).Bóg nie odpowie na te pytania: możemy pytać Go o wszystko tylko nie o przyczynę rzeczy; nie mamy prawa żądać, by się przed nami tłumaczył. W rzeczywistości Bóg wciąż i wciąż do nas mówi; i to my jesteśmy tymi, którzy nie stają w jego obecności i dlatego nie słyszymy jego głosu. «To my --mówi Benedykt XVI— nie jesteśmy w stanie ocenić tajemnicy Boga. Widzimy tylko fragmenty i mylimy się chcąc być sędziami Boga i historii. Przez to nie jesteśmy obrońcami człowieka, lecz bierzemy udział w zniszczeniu».

Problemem nie jest to, czy Bóg istnieje czy nie, lecz że my ludzie żyjemy tak, jakby Go nie było. A oto odpowiedź Boga: «Czemu tak bojaźliwi jesteście? Jakże wam brak wiary?» (Mk 4,40). Powiedział to Jezus do apostołów i to samo rzekł do Faustyny Kowalskiej: «Córko, nie lękaj się niczego, Ja zawsze jestem z tobą, nawet wtedy, kiedy ci się wydaje, że mnie nie ma».

Nie zadawajmy Mu pytań, a raczej módlmy się i słuchajmy jego woli i..., wtedy właśnie będzie mniej tragedii..., i wówczas zadziwieni zawołamy: «Kim właściwie On jest, że nawet wicher i jezioro są Mu posłuszne?» (Mk 4,41). — Jezu, ufam Tobie!



CATECHISM of the CATHOLIC CHURCH

What role does Sacred Scripture play in the Church? The Church draws her life and strength from Sacred Scripture. Besides the presence of Christ in the Holy → EUCHARIST, there is nothing that the Church honors more reverently than Christ's presence in Sacred Scripture. At Holy Mass we receive the Gospel standing, because in the human words we hear, God himself speaks to us.

How can we respond to God when he speaks to us?

To respond to God means to believe him. Anyone who wants to believe needs a heart that is ready to listen (see 1 Kings 3:9). In many ways God seeks contact with us. In every human encounter, in every moving experience of nature, in every apparent coincidence, in every challenge, every suffering, there is a hidden message from God to us. He speaks even more clearly to us when he turns to us in his Word or in the voice of our conscience. He addresses us as friends. Therefore we, too, should respond as friends and believe him, trust him completely, learn to understand him better and better, and accept his will without reservation.


