We are slowly returning to normal functioning in the Church, in public and private life. This does not mean, however, that the time of pandemic and danger to human life has passed. So we still have to follow the rules set by the government and the diocese. After four months of pandemic, I want to say thank you again. MASSES RESUMED AT LIMITED CAPACITY
