Bóg dając nam życie, dał nam również pewne możliwości —małe lub większe—rozwoju osobistego, etycznego i religijnego. Bez względu na to, czy ktoś ma dużo czy mało, ważne jest to, by umiał wykorzystać to co otrzymał. Człowiek z naszej przypowieści, który ukrywa swój talent w obawie przed swym panem, nie umie podjąć ryzyka: «Ten zaś, który otrzymał jeden, poszedł i rozkopawszy ziemię, ukrył pieniądze swego pana» (Mt 25,18). Za sedno przypowieści możemy traktować, to że powinniśmy mieć koncepcję Boga, który popycha nas do przekraczania samych siebie, który zachęca nas do życia w wolności Królestwa Bożego.

*Dear Parishioners and Friends of
St. Hedwig's Church,*

Today, Jesus tells us another parable of judgment. We are approaching Advent season and, therefore, the end of the liturgical year is getting near. By giving us life, God has also provided us with the possibility —smaller or bigger— of personal, ethical and religious development. It does not matter if we have more or less, what matters is that what we have received has to yield some profit. The man of our parable, who hides his talent for fear of his master, did not want to run any risks: «But the man who received one [talent] went off and dug a hole in the ground and buried his master's money» (Mt 25:18). Maybe the core of the parable is this: we must conceive a God that motivates us to come out of ourselves, who encourages us to the freedom of the Kingdom of God.

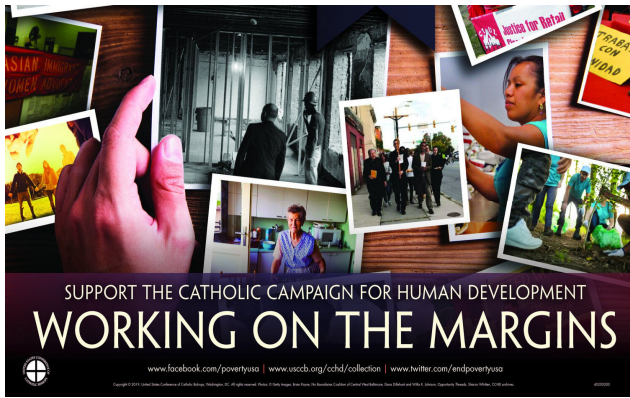

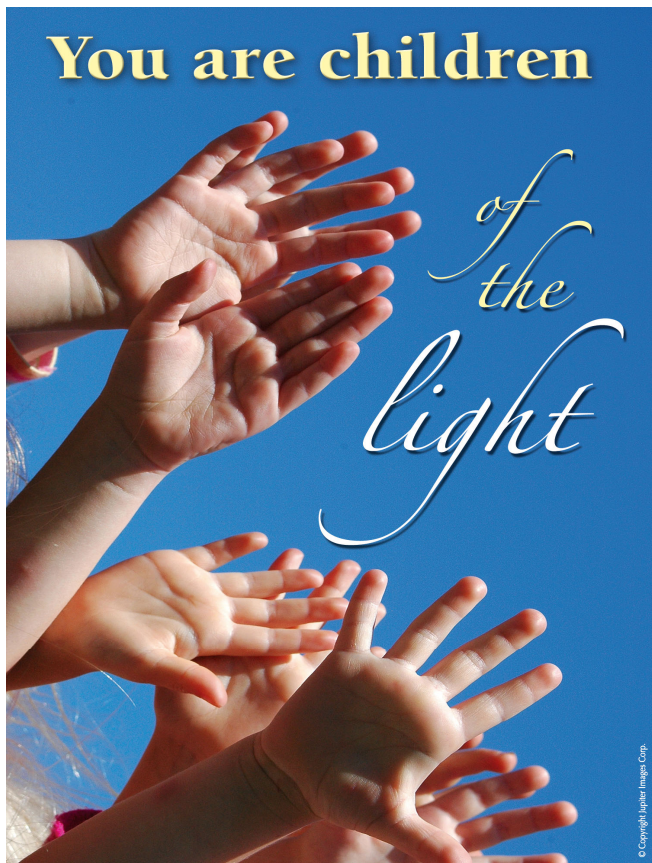

CHANGE OUR LIVES

The letters of Paul to the Thessalonians are among his earliest writings, and are driven by his belief and the belief of the entire early Christian community that the return of Christ was imminent, and that devoting time or attention to anything else was foolish.

As time progressed, this fervor subsided a bit. Today we may wonder, when we hear these readings about the coming end-times, if we should take them to heart, if we really believe that Christ still may come upon us as a “thief at night” (1 Thessalonians 5:2). Does this mean that we are to stop our long-range goal-setting, get rid of our yearly calendars and planners, or stop putting money in the college education fund? Of course not. What it does mean is that we need to change our lives, living like children of the light and illuminating the world around us with the light of the gospel. Then, on that day, when the details of our daily living become unimportant, we will be ready to find our peace and security in Christ Jesus.
