

Dzisiaj kontemplujemy Jezusa w Kafarnaum, centrum jego posługi, a konkretnie w domu Szymona Piotra. Teściowa Piotra jest chora w łóżku, a On podaje jej rękę, podnosi i przywraca do zdrowia.

Zbliża się do biednych-cierpiących, których przyprowadzają do Niego i uzdrawia ich wyciągając dłoń; zaledwie poprzez krótki kontakt z Nim, który jest źródłem życia, zostają uwolnienizbawieni.

Wszyscy szukają Chrystusa, niektórzy wyraźnie i z wysiłkiem, inni może nie będąc tego świadomi, jako że «niespokojne jest serce nasze, dopóki w Nim nie spocznie» (Święty Augustyn).

Ale tak jak my Go szukamy, bo potrzebujemy, by nas uwolnił od Zła, tak On zbliża się do nas, aby umożliwić to, czego nigdy byśmy nie osiągnęli na własną rękę.

Wyciągnięta jest w naszą stronę dłoń, którą nie widzimy przytłoczeni przez tak wiele zła; wystarczy, byśmy otworzyli naszą i powstaniemy odnowieni do służby. Możemy "otworzyć" dłoń poprzez modlitwę.

Ponadto, coniedzielna Eucharystia jest spotkaniem z Panem, który przychodzi, by podnieść nas z grzechu i zniechęcenia, i rutyny, aby uczynić z nas żywych świadków spotkania, które nieustannie nas odnawia, i czyni nas prawdziwie wolnymi w Jezusie Chrystusie.(Źródło: evangeli.net)

The poor and ailing people are brought to him and Jesus heals them with the simple touch of his hand, which is a source of life. They are free and saved.





Ash Wednesday - Feb. 17th

Looking ahead to Ash Wednesday: Due to the pandemic, the Imposition of Ashes will take place significantly differently this year. Instead of receiving ashes in the sign of the cross on the forehead, ashes will be sprinkled on the head of each person. This is a form commonly used in Europe and elsewhere in the church, that we will be using here this year. More about this procedure as we get closer to Ash Wednesday.

The reason I have been writing about Ash Wednesday so early on is because I want everyone to know that we are taking every precaution that our services will be well planned and safe. As mentioned previously, we will NOT be applying ashes on foreheads, but will be handing mini envelopes of ashes to people as they come up to receive ashes. Please trust that we are doing everything we can to keep everyone safe.




The Floral Park Police Department recently announced an At-Risk Resident Program. It is geared toward people who may wander or elope or get lost and have trouble communicating or seeking out help.

Faith Formation classes are held on Thursdays: Grades 1-5 from 5:00 - 6:00pm Grades 6-8 from 6:15 - 7:15pm




Structure of the catechetical program:
