

Beatification of Cardinal Stefan Wyszynski—Primate of Poland September 12, 2021



during Stalinism. Wyszyński became death of his predecessor, Cardinal rank of Cardinal by the Holy See on munist regime decided to put him resistance against the communist system espoused by the Polish Catholic church. He was released after three years, following the events of the so-called "Polish October" and the end


of Stalinism in 1956. In 1966, Cardinal Wyszyński presided over the celebration marking the millennium since Poland's Christianisation in the year of 966. The celebrations took place in rivalry with the communist regime which organized a state-led celebration of a millenium of Polish statehood. The election of Cardinal Karol Wojtyła as Pope in 1979 is considered one of Cardinal Wyszyński's life achievements. He passed in 1981 at the age of 79 following a battle with abdominal cancer. He died on May 28, 1981. Hudreds of thousands of Poles participated in Cardinal Wyszyński's funeral, which turned into a huge patriotic manifestation against the communist regime. He is buried in St. John's Archeathedral in Warsaw. The process leading to his beatification started in 1989 but it wasn't until the congregation for the Causes of the Saints had officially approved one of his miracles on October 3, 2019 that it became clear Cardinal Wyszyński would be beatified. The beatification of Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński, the former Primate of Poland who heroically resisted communism, takes place on September 12, 2021 in Warsaw. Toghether with Wyszyński will be beatified Sr. Róża Maria Czacka, a Polish nun who died in 1961 after a lifetime of service to blind people.

Stefan Wyszyński was born on August 3, 1901 in the village of Zuzela in eastern Mazovia on the Bug River. Wyszyński's mother died when he was nine. In 1912, his father sent him to Warsaw. In the years 1914-1916 Stefan attended the high-school in Łomża. The following year he enrolled in the seminary in Włocławek, and on his 24th birthday (August 3, 1924), after being hospitalized with a serious illness, he received his priestly ordination from Bishop Adalberto Owczarek. Father Wyszyński spent the next four years in Lublin, where in 1929 he received a doctorate at the Faculty of Canon Law and the Social Sciences of the Catholic University of Lublin. On March 25, 1946, Pope Pius XII appointed him Bishop of Lublin. He served as the bishop of Lublin from 1946 to 1948. On October 22, 1948, he was named Metropolitan Archbishop of Gniezno and Warsaw, and thus Primate of Poland, on November 12, 1948. He served there to 1981. He was created a cardinal on January 12, 1953 by Pope Pius XII as the Cardinal-Priest of Santa Maria in Trastevere. He assumed the title of Primate of Poland. Stefan Wyszyński was often

called the "Primate of the Millennium" in Poland. He is venerated in Poland as a religious and also political leader, who guided the nation in some of its most difficult moments the Primate of Poland in 1948 following the August Hlond. Wyszyński was elevated to the January 12, 1953. Only months later, the comunder house arrest in revenge for the calls for
