UPDATE

We pray that you and your families are doing well. If there are people for whom we should be praying, please send us their names and we will add them to the prayer list. Below is the information that was given as the announcements at Mass this weekend:

"With regard to the re-opening of churches and the celebration of the Sacraments. It seems that what Churches are allowed and not allowed to do is changing daily. Please keep checking the parish website during the week for current, accurate information.

For us at St. Hedwig's Church, the Diocese of Rockville Centre directives will determine the path we take towards re-opening. We know that the Diocese is in regular communication with the local civil authorities and medical advisors; and I am confident they will make the best decisions for people's health – both physical and spiritual.

1. At the current time funerals and baptisms with 10 or fewer people present are permitted. Please wear a mask.

2. As long as we remain limited to 10 persons at a gathering, we will continue with recorded Masses only. When we are permitted to have larger, socially distant gatherings, either inside or outside, we will begin Masses with congregations, while also continuing a recorded Mass.

3. No Rectory Office visits. Calls only: (516) 354-0042 (from 9 am –till 5pm)

4. Parishioners are encouraged to engage in personal and family prayer,(e.g. the Rosary) at home.

5. Please contact Fr. Peter at (516)776-5486 if there are any concerns about visiting and anointing of the sick at home, in nursing homes and hospitals.

6. The Catholic Faith Network (CFN) will provide televised and online daily Masses, including Holy Week and Easter Liturgies, as well as other devotional and spiritual programs. (Optimum channel 29/137, Verizon FiOS TV channel 296, and Spectrum channel 162/471.) CFN is also available on selected cable and satellite systems and through 24/7 live stream at CFNtv.org. You can also watch CFN on Roku, Apple TV, Amazon Fire TV, Android, or by downloading the CFN iOS mobile app at the app store by searching "Catholic Faith Network" or "CFN".

7. Currently, our Catholic Schools are closed **UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE**, following the measures taken by Nassau and Suffolk public schools. However, we continue to monitor the situation and will adapt and update as needed. Our parish Religious Education programs will remain suspended **UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE**. Again,

we continue to monitor the situation and will adapt and update as needed.

In the readings on Pentecost Sunday, the Spirit is described as a driving wind and tongues of fire. Knowing that the Holy Spirit is a Person of the Trinity, we seem to be able to picture the Spirit only in terms of what the Spirit does. In our second reading, Paul tries to explain just that. First, Paul says that we cannot know Jesus as Lord without the Spirit. The Spirit is the way Jesus is present today, so anyone who truly believes in Jesus is guided by the Spirit. Second, he acknowledges that the Spirit works in many ways. As examples, Paul mentions there are many different gifts and services in the church. He emphasizes that all these differences come from one and the same God.

When we think of the strength of the Church, we usually think of its unity, i.e., one baptism, one faith, one Lord. But we also draw strength from the diversity of gifts and services that people offer to God. So look at the gifts of those around you, and you may be able to see the Holy Spirit more clearly.
