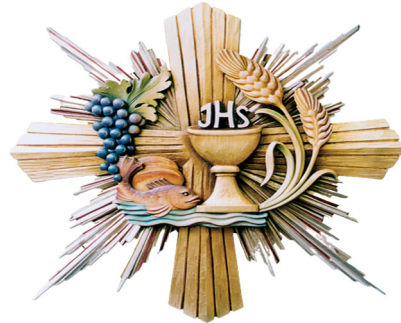

LIST KSIĘDZA PROBOSZCZA

Drodzy Parafianie i Przyjaciele,

Dzisiaj Ewangelia przedstawia postać niewiernego zarządcy, który korzystał ze swojej funkcji, aby okradać swojego pana. Był zwyczajnym rządcą, a zachowywał się jak pan. Warto byśmy zawsze mieli na uwadze, że:

1) Dobra materialne są dobrymi rzeczywistościami, ponieważ wyszły z rąk Boga. Dlatego należy je kochać. 2) Lecz nie możemy ich "czcić" jakby były Bogiem i celem naszej egzystencji; mamy się od nich uwalniać. Bogactwa istnieją po to, by służyć Bogu i braciom, nie mają służyć do detronizacji Boga z naszych serc i z naszych dzieł: «Nie możecie służyć Bogu i Mamonie» (Łk 16,13). 3) Nie jesteśmy panami dóbr materialnych, lecz zwykłymi zarządcami i dlatego mamy je nie tylko zachowywać, ale także pomnażać w miarę naszych możliwości. Doskonale obrazuje to przypowieść o talentach (cf. Mt 25,14-30). 4) Nie możemy popaść w skąpstwo, lecz żyć w wolności, która jest wartością chrześcijańską bogatych i biednych w każdych okolicznościach. Mamy dawać innym! A jeśli nie wystarcza ci na pokrycie własnych wydatków? Tak, nawet wtedy masz się starać pomnażać dobra, aby dać innym więcej (w parafii, diecezji, Caritas, apostolacie). Jesteś egoistą, jeśli myślisz tylko o gromadzeniu dóbr dla siebie jak ów zarządca z Ewangelii. Kłamstwo, rabunek, sknerstwo i zatwardziałość serca zamykają cię na potrzeby innych. Czy myślisz często o słowach Świętego Pawła: «Radosnego dawcę miłuje Bóg» (2Kor 9,7)? Bądź hojny!

LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Today, the Gospel introduces us to the figure of the unfaithful steward: a man rendering a fraudulent service to his master. He is just a simple steward, but behaves as his master. We must bear in mind:

1) Material goods are actually necessary and good, because they come from God's hands. Consequently, we have to prize them. 2) But we cannot "worship" them as if they were God and the ultimate meaning or purpose to our existence; we have to be open-handed. Riches are meant for us to better serve God and men, our brothers; not to expel God from our heart and our deeds: «You cannot give yourself both to God and to Money» (Lk 16:13). 3) We are not owners, but simple stewards; therefore, not only are we supposed to be trustworthy with whatever we administer, but we are also to make it yield to the best of our possibilities. The parable of the talents shows it quite clearly (cf. Mt 25:14-30). 4) Do not let greed drag us along; we have to practice liberality, which is a virtue we should all have, whether rich or poor, each one depending upon his circumstances. We have to give others! What if I have enough for my own expenses? Yes, you must also try to increase your wealth to be able to give more (parish, diocese, Caritas, apostolate). Are you so selfish that you only think of amassing material goods, even if it is as the Gospel's steward did, by lying, stealing, by being stingy, hard-hearted and indifferent to others' needs? Do you ever ponder over St. Paul's words? «God loves a cheerful giver» (2Cor 9:7). Be generous!

COUNTER TO OUR EXPECTATIONS

When we listen to the scriptures at liturgy, there is kind of an unspoken idea that we will hear something amazing and uplifting, that will stir our hearts into flame and make us better Catholics, better Christians, better people, as we carry the Living Word of God out in our lives. So how surprising is it when we get a day like today, when so much seems to run counter to our expectations? Amos warns us about cheating and taking away someone's rights. In Paul's first letter to Timothy, he explains we must pray for everyone, no matter what we think of them, even if they are in a place of power and authority. And Jesus' praise of the "children of this world" in today's Gospel passage is really disconcerting!

JUSTICE FOR ALL

When we grasp a better understanding of Amos, it really is a mirror of the Gospel message that we must be good stewards and offer kindness and justice to all. Remember that Jesus is in the midst of speaking through a series of parables. (We left off with the Prodigal Son last week.) When he is speaking of the steward, he is not telling us to get into money laundering or get-rich-quick schemes or engage in multi-level marketing. Rather, we can infer that we are to use our goods and our skills wisely and for the betterment of everyone. In the parable the steward is praised for his quick thinking and for finding a way to resolve the situation. The parable ends with Jesus telling us "You cannot serve God and mammon" and you must make a choice.

EVERYTHING IS A CHOICE

The Gospel parable tells us what the steward did one time to get out of a bind. But we are called to make the right choice, the best choice over and over. Sometimes it is hard. You may not be choosing between good and evil, but sometimes even have to choose between two goods. We frequently have to make choices like, "Do I spend this extra time at work to get that promotion? Do I bring the work home with me? Or am I able to leave it there and be with my family when I am done?" Parents often have to look at their savings account before they determine which activities they can afford for their children to participate in. Music and sports and the arts are wonderful, but all require special equipment and time. But making a sacrifice on everybody's part might reap great rewards. Sometimes, though, the choice is made to just get food on the table, or to clothe the family. We learn to make the choices that are best for ourselves and are decisions we can live with. We learn to discern what is best for those we love.

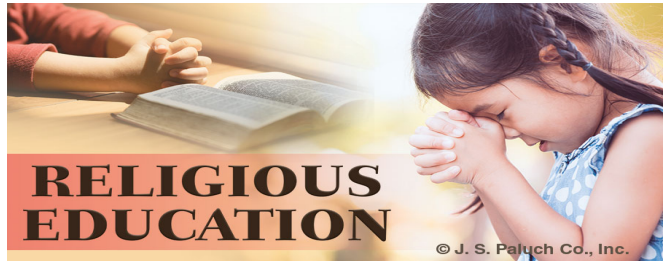
