Drodzy Parafianie i Przyjaciele,

Dzisiaj, Ewangelia zaprasza nas do zwrócenia oczu na krzyż, gdzie Chrystus umiera na Kalwarii. Widzimy pasterza oddającego życie za owce. I nad nim wydnieje napis: «To jest Król Żydowski» (Łk 23,38). Oto ten, który cierpi ogromną mękę i którego oblicze zdeformowano jest Królem. Czy to możliwe? Doskonale zrozumiał to jeden ze skazanych i ukrzyżowanych obok Pana Jezusa dobry łotr. Prosi z wiarą: «Jezu, wspomnij na mnie, gdy przyjdiesz do swego królestwa» (Łk 23,42). Odpowiedź Jezusa jest pocieszająca i pewna: «Zaprawdę, powiadam ci: Dziś ze Mną będziesz w raju» (Łk 23,43).

Wyznajmy, że Jezus jest Królem. “Królem” przez wielkie “K”. Nigdy nikt nie będzie godzien takiej królewskiej godności. Królestwo Jezusa nie jest z tego świata. Jest to Królestwo, do którego wchodzi się przez nawrócenie na chrześcijaństwo. To Królestwo prawdy i życia, Królestwo świętości i łaski, Królestwo sprawiedliwości, miłości i pokoju. Królestwo, które rodzi się z Krwi i wody, która wypłynęła z boku ukrzyżowanego Jezusa Chrystusa.

Today's Gospel makes us raise our eyes to the cross on which Christ is in agony on Calvary. Here we see the Good Shepherd giving up his life for his flock. And, there up high is the sign that reads, "This is the King of the Jews" (Lk 23:38). This man who is suffering so horribly whose face has been so disfigured, is the King? Could it be possible? The good thief, one of the two men condemned at each side of Jesus, understands. He says with faith, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom" (Lk 23:42). THE THRONE OF THE CROSS

We conclude the liturgical year today with the Solemnity of Christ the King. On the surface, we might wonder what this has to do with our lives. Why does it matter that Christ is King? Do we need a king? If we are honest with ourselves, we must admit that we do need someone to follow, a king who will rule our hearts, minds, and lives with goodness. Left to our own devices, following our own tendencies, we are bound to fall short of God's great call to grow and live in holiness. Christ will shepherd us, not from a position of power or authority, although both are his as well, but rather from the throne of the cross, the throne of humility, compassion, and peace.

JESUS, THE IMAGE OF THE INVISIBLE GOD

Part of the challenge of living as a child of God is not being able to see God, to know what God is like. Believing in God requires faith, the willingness to enter into a mystery that is timeless and yet timely—as true today as it has been throughout the ages. Placing our faith in Jesus does not require us to put rational thought behind. Rather, in Jesus, we see God, the creator of all that is, including our intellect, the ability to understand our experience, and more. Jesus makes God visible, he is the image of the invisible God, the sign of God's determination that we not be separated from God, the one who shows us creation's ultimate purpose. When we wonder what God is like, what God desires, or how God acts, we need only look to Christ, who pours out his life in God's compassionate love.

JESUS, REMEMBER ME

The repentant thief in today's Gospel gives us a lasting image of Christ's undying love and forgiveness. As Jesus is dying on the cross, the thief declares his belief in Jesus, the King. Jesus recognizes his faith and makes his own declaration: "today you will be with me in Paradise." As we come to the end of the liturgical year and prepare to enter into Advent, it is good for us to ask ourselves if we, too, are ready to declare our belief that Jesus is the Christ, the image of the unseen God, the one who was and is and is to come. As we reaffirm our faith, let us place our hearts, minds, and lives in the hands of the King who reigns now and will reign into eternity.

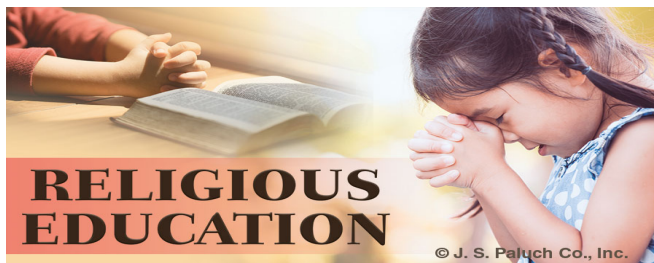
