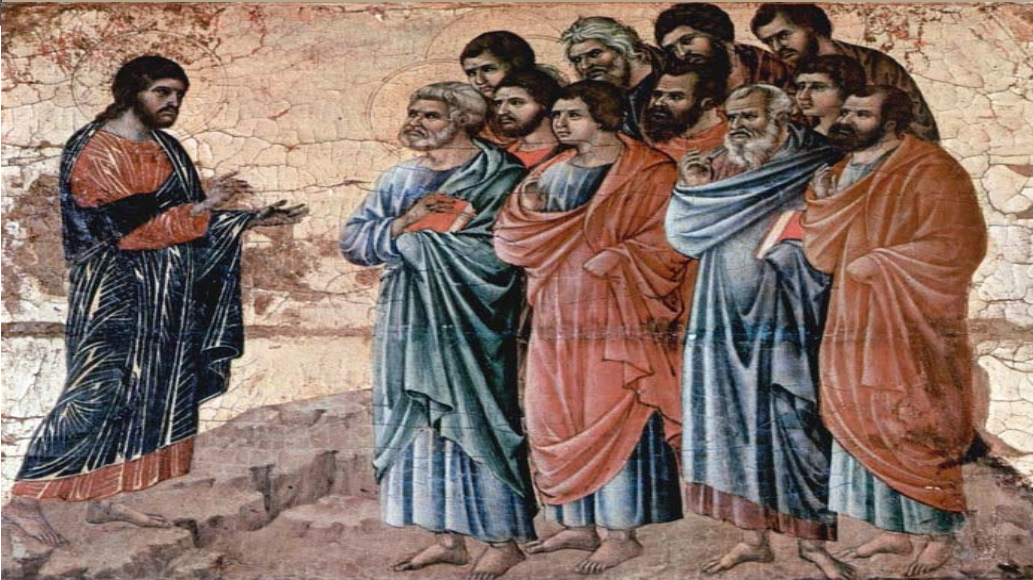

# SUNDAY REFLECTION

Today, the Gospel still places us in Easter Sunday, when the two disciples from Emmaus return to Jerusalem and, there, while everyone recounts that the Lord has appeared to them, the same Risen One presents Himself to them. But His presence is disconcerting. On the one hand, it causes fear, to the point that they "thought that they were seeing a ghost" (Lk 24:37) and, on the other hand, his body pierced by the nails and the lance is an eloquent testimony that it is Jesus Himself, the crucified one: "Look at my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Touch me and see, because a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you can see I have" (Lk 24:39).

"LORD, show us the light of your face!" sings the psalm of today's liturgy. Indeed, Jesus "opened their minds to understand the Scriptures" (Lk 24:45). It is absolutely urgent. It is necessary that the disciples have a precise and deep understanding of the Scriptures, since, in the words of Saint Jerome, "to ignore the Scriptures is to ignore Christ."

But this understanding of the word of God is not a fact that one can manage privately, or with his congregation of friends and acquaintances. The Lord revealed the meaning of the Scriptures to the Church in that Easter community, presided over by Peter and the other Apostles, who were commissioned by the Master that it "would be preached in his name to all the nations" (Lk 24:47).


To be witnesses, therefore, of the authentic Christ, it is urgent that the disciples learn—first of all—to recognize his Body marked by the passion. Precisely, an ancient author makes the following recommendation: "He who knows that the Paschal lamb has been sacrificed for him must understand that his life begins when Christ has died to save us." Furthermore, the apostle must intelligently understand the Scriptures, read in the light of the Spirit of truth poured out on the Church.

# APOSTOLAT POLSKI

## ZAREJESTRUJ SIĘ DO NASZEJ PARAFII



Serdecznie witamy nowych członków parafii i zapraszamy do rejestracji w Biurze Parafialnym. Rejestracji w kościele św. ## KATECHIZM KOŚCIOŁA KATOLICKIEGO

*Co Bóg objawia o sobie samym, kiedy posyła do nas swojego Syna?*

Bóg objawia nam w Jezusie Chrystusie całą głębię swojej miłosiernej miłości. Przez Jezusa Chrystusa niewidzialny Bóg staje się widzialny. Staje się człowiekiem jak my. To pokazuje nam, jak daleko sięga Boża miłość: niesie cały nasz ciężar. Idzie z nami wszystkimi drogami. Jest w naszym opuszczeniu, naszych cierpieniach, naszym strachu przed śmiercią. Jest tam, gdzie my nie jesteśmy już dalej w stanie otworzyć się na życie.

## ROZWAŻANIE NA NIEDZIELE

Dzisiaj Ewangelia jeszcze nas umiejscawia w niedzielę zmartwychwstania, kiedy dwóch z Emaus wraca do Jerozolimy, dołącza do pozostałych uczniów, a tam, podczas gdy to jeden, to drugi opowiada, że Pan im się ukazał, sam Zmartwychwstały staje pośród nich. Ale jego obecność wprowadza niepokój. Z jednej strony budzi trwogę, tak dalece, że zebrany „zdawało się, że widzą ducha” (Łk 24,37), z drugiej jego ciało przebite gwoździami i włócznią, jest wymownym świadectwem tego, że to Jezus ukrzyżowany we własnej osobie: Popatrzcie na moje ręce i nogi: to Ja jestem. Dotknijcie się Mnie i przekonajcie: duch nie ma ciała ani kości, jak widzicie, że Ja mam“ (Łk. 24, 39).

“Wznies ponad nami, o Panie, światłość Twojego oblicza!” śpiewa psalm dzisiejszej liturgii. Istotnie, Jezus “oświecił ich umysły, aby rozumieli Pisma” (Łk, 24,45). To nad wyraz ważne. Uczniowie muszą być obdarzeni głęboką i dokładną znajomością Pism, albowiem, jak mówił, święty Hieronim “Nieznajomość Pism jest nieznanością Chrystusa”.

Ale owo zrozumienie słowa Bożego nie jest wiedzą, którą można zdobyć prywatnie czy też w grupie swoich przyjaciół czy kolegów. Pan ujawnił sens Pism Kościołowi podczas owej wspólnoty paschalnej, przewodzonej przez Piotra i innych Apostołów, którym Nauczyciel nakazał, by głosić “nawrócenie w jego imię... wszystkim narodom” (Łk 24, 47).

Niemniej, żeby być świadkami autentycznego Chrystusa, uczniowie muszą – przede wszystkim – wiedzieć jak rozpoznać jego Ciało naznaczone męką. Jeden z dawnych autorów przekazuje nam następujące zalecenie: “Každy kto wie, iż Wielkanoc została poświęcona dla niego, musi pojąć, że jego życie zaczyna się, kiedy Jezus zmarł, aby nas zbawić?”. Ponadto apostoł musi rozumnie pojmować Pisma, czytane w świetle Ducha prawdy, który został rozlany nad Kościołem.
