

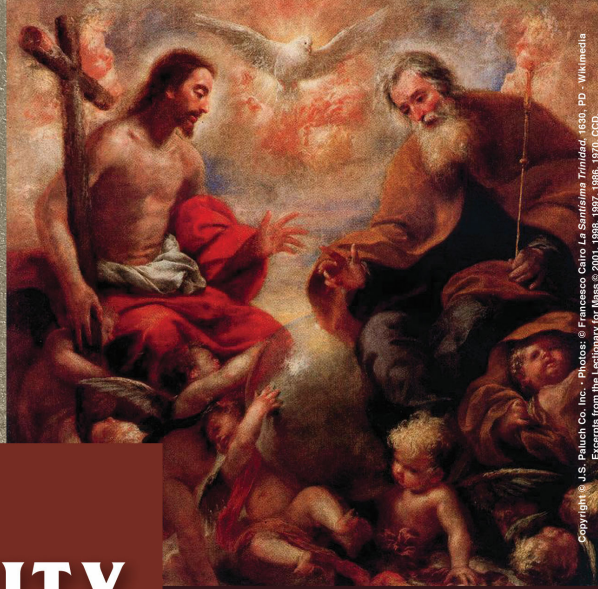

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Hedwig's Church:

Writing this letter for Holy Trinity Sunday, I have this great desire to discover the mystery of God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Every year I have the same experience and the same thought that I need more cooperation with God to understand Him.

Jesus said:

Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age. Mt.28:19-20

The Holy Trinity is the mystery of three Persons in one God, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The mystery of the Trinity is the object of faith in the Tradition of the Church only because it was revealed by Jesus Christ, the divine Son of the eternal Father. The Trinity is inaccessible to the human mind. Note that in the above biblical passage, Matthew has written "to baptize in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit," for there is only one God. Let the Holy Trinity surround us with his majesty and power.

UPDATE

We pray that you and your families are doing well. If there are people for whom we should be praying, please send us their names and we will add them to the prayer list. Below is the information that was given as the announcements at Mass this weekend:

"With regard to the re-opening of churches and the celebration of the Sacraments. It seems that what Churches are allowed and not allowed to do is changing daily. Please keep checking the parish website during the week for current, accurate information.

For us at St. Hedwig's Church, the Diocese of Rockville Centre directives will determine the path we take towards re-opening. We know that the Diocese is in regular communication with the local civil authorities and medical advisors; and I am confident they will make the best decisions for people's health – both physical and spiritual.

1. At the current time funerals and baptisms with 10 or fewer people present are permitted. Please wear a mask.
2. As long as we remain limited to 10 persons at a gathering, we will continue with recorded Masses only. When we are permitted to have larger, socially distant gatherings, either inside or outside, we will begin Masses with congregations, while also continuing a recorded Mass.
3. No Rectory Office visits. Calls only: (516) 354-0042 (from 9 am –till 5pm)
4. Parishioners are encouraged to engage in personal and family prayer,(e.g. the Rosary) at home.
5. Please contact Fr. Peter at (516)776-5486 if there are any concerns about visiting and anointing of the sick at home, in nursing homes and hospitals.
6. The Catholic Faith Network (CFN) will provide televised and online daily Masses, including Holy Week and Easter Liturgies, as well as other devotional and spiritual programs. (Optimum channel 29/137, Verizon FiOS TV channel 296, and Spectrum channel 162/471.) CFN is also available on selected cable and satellite systems and through 24/7 live stream at CFNtv.org. You can also watch CFN on Roku, Apple TV, Amazon Fire TV, Android, or by downloading the CFN iOS mobile app at the app store by searching "Catholic Faith Network" or "CFN".
7. Currently, our Catholic Schools are closed **UNTIL**

FURTHER NOTICE. Our parish Religious Education programs will remain suspended **UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.** Again, we continue to monitor the situation and will adapt and update as needed.

Why does God love us so much? And why are we able to love others? The answer to these questions is found in the meaning of today's feast. Trinity Sunday celebrates not so much an idea of three-in-one as the relationship of the Persons of the Trinity with each other and with us.

The idea is that the Father expressed himself as the Word. Since it was a perfect expression, the Word is his Son and equal to the Father. The love of Father and Son is expressed as the Holy Spirit. Being a perfect love, it too is equal to Father and Son. So even the idea of the Trinity is based on love. But God's love was so great, God went even further. God created us to be loved by God.

In the second reading Paul blesses the Corinthians with the "love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit." The book of Genesis (3:18) says that it was not good for man to be alone. So God created woman, and through man and woman all humanity, to be able to love each other. Though human love is not perfect, the love of man and woman can produce another person, a child. The three Persons of the Trinity share one life in God. But through baptism, we also share in God's life. Just as parents love to see how their children look like them, so God loves to see the divine in us.

The first reading reminds us of God's closeness to humanity. Moses can speak to God and God responds by granting his request. The Gospel tells how much God loves the world, that God's own Son was sent to die for us. But we sometimes forget that God's love comes first. We think that the more loving we are, the more God will love us. But love comes from God (1 John 4:7-11), so when we love someone it doesn't make God love us more; we love because God loves us first. Our decision to love is a response to God's love, and our ability to love is itself a gift from God. The meaning of life, the universe, and everything is Love, the love of the Trinity for each other and for us. The question now is, how well do we use that gift of God's love by loving each other?
