***“Do not be afraid of those who kill the body”***

Today, after choosing the twelve, Jesus sends them to preach and instructs them. He warns them about the persecution they may likely suffer and advises them on their attitude: “Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; rather, be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna” (Mt 10,28). The narrative of this Sunday develops the theme of persecution in a style reminiscent of the last Beatitude of the Sermon on the Mount (cf. Mt 5,11).

Jesus' speech is paradoxical: on the one hand, he tells us “Do not be afraid”, and he presents us with a providential Father who cares even for sparrows; on the other hand, he does not tell us that this Father will save us from troubles, rather the opposite: if we are his followers, we are likely to share his fate and that of the other prophets.


So, how can we understand this? God's protection is his ability to give life to our person (our soul), and to provide happiness even in tribulations and persecutions. He is the one who can give us the joy of His Kingdom —which we can already enjoy here— and is our hope of eternal life: “Everyone who acknowledges me before others I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father.”


Trusting that God will be with us in difficult times gives us courage to speak Jesus' words in the light (cf Mt 10:27); moreover, it gives us the energy we need to do good, so that through our works people can give glory to our heavenly Father. Accordingly, Saint Anselm teaches us: “Do everything for God and for that happy and eternal life our Savior deigns to grant us in Heaven.”

## SŁOWO NA NIEDZIELE

**«Nie bójcie się tych, którzy zabijają ciało»**

Dzisiaj Jezus po wybraniu dwunastu posyła ich i udziela im instrukcji. Ostrzega ich przed prześladowaniem, którego prawdopodobnie doświadczą i radzi, jaka powinna być ich postawa: «Nie bójcie się tych, którzy zabijają ciało, lecz duszy zabić nie mogą. Bójcie się raczej Tego, który duszę i ciało może zatracić w piekle» (Mt 10,28). Słowo tej niedzieli rozwija temat prześladowania z powodu Jezusa w stylu, który przypomina ostatnie Błogosławieństwo z Kazania na Górze (cf. Mt 5,11).

Wywód Jezusa jest paradoksalny: z jednej strony dwa razy mówi "nie bójcie się" i przedstawia Ojca, który dba nawet o polne ptaki, a z drugiej, nie mówi nam, że ten Ojciec oszczędzi nam przeciwności, a wręcz przeciwnie: jeśli będziemy jego naśladowcami, najprawdopodobniej spotka nas taki sam los, jak Jego czy innych proroków. Jak to rozumieć? Ochrona Boga polega na zdolności dawania życia naszej osobie (naszej duszy), dawania szczęścia nawet podczas przeciwności i prześladowań. On może dać nam radość jego Królestwa, która wynika z głębokiego doświadczenia jej już tutaj na ziemi jako zadatku życia wiecznego: «Do każdego więc, który się przyzna do Mnie przed ludźmi, przyznam się i Ja przed moim Ojcem» (Mt 10,32). Ufność, że Bóg jest z nami w każdym trudnym momencie życia daje nam siłę głoszenia słów Jezusa w pełnym świetle. Daje nam też zdolność czynienia dobra tak, aby dzięki naszym czynkom ludzie mogli chwalić Boga w niebie. Święty Anzelm poucza nas: «Czyńcie wszystko dla Boga i dla tego szczęśliwego i wiecznego życia, które nasz Zbawiciel obiecał wam dać w niebie».

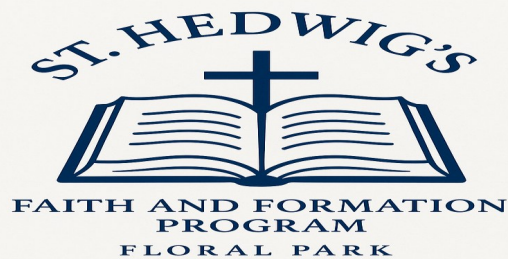
**Episode 4: The Faithful Departed:** Looks at how the living can care for the body and soul of the deceased through grief, funerals, and prayer.

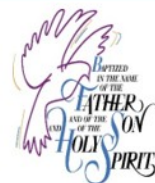

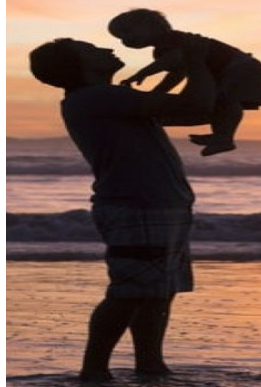
